Job Title: APRN

Reports to: Collaborative Practice Provider and Office Manager

APRN or Role:

The APRN is a licensed practitioner who works collaboratively with other healthcare professionals to deliver family-focused care. They are responsible for managing health problems and coordinating health care in accordance with State and Federal rules and regulations and the nursing standards of care (assessment of health status, diagnosis, development of plan of care and treatment, implementation of treatment plan, and evaluation of patient status). Adheres to the highest professional ethical standards

APRN Essential responsibilities:

- Functions independently to perform age-appropriate history and physical for complex acute, critical, and chronically ill patients.
- Orders and interprets diagnostic and therapeutic tests relative to patient's age-specific needs.
- Prescribes appropriate pharmacologic and non-pharmacologic treatment modalities
- Instruct and counsel patients regarding compliance with prescribed therapeutic regimens
- Develop and implements patient management plans in conjunction with Care Coordinators.
- Facilitates staff, patient and family decision making by providing educational tools
- Collaborates with multidisciplinary team members by making appropriate referrals.
- Focused emphasis on Preventative Care and monitors the effectiveness of interventions.
- Consults with Collaborative Physician as necessary.
- Provides surgical, suturing and wound care in accordance with facility, state, and federal regulations.
- Facilitates the patient's transition within and between health care settings, e.g. admitting, transferring, and discharging patients.
- Participate in community health fairs and provide health education at community organizations.
- May perform triage as necessary.
- Be responsible for maintaining work relationship with LPN and MA and other practice staff.
- Participation on agreed to committee assignments and other duties as assigned

APRN Minimum qualifications

- Graduate of an accredited APRN Program
- Current APRN Licensure
- Current provider card in Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) Preferred

- Must possess a valid driver's license
- Strong EMR and computer skills, including Word, Excel, and PowerPoint
- Eligible for hospital privileges if required
- Candidate must agree to terms and conditions of the PROVIDER EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT.
